Angel Tree

Angel Tree spreads Christmas cheer by helping children whose parents are incarcerated through FBM small groups. This ministry takes place from mid-November to early December.

Backpack Blowout

Backpack Blowout equips the young people of our community with the tools for success as they embark on a new school year. This ministry assists the community with meeting the health needs required for school enrollment, shares Christ's love, and plants seeds for spiritual growth.

Serving with Backpack Blowout will begin with a volunteer meeting in mid-July, followed by filling backpacks in late July. Backpack Blowout will be in early August.

Build Up Ministry

This team provides God-given skills to complete small construction projects for communities or organizations in need. Serving with this ministry requires experience in carpentry, plumbing, electrical, painting, and general labor/cleanup. This team also provides small repair and maintenance assistance for senior church members over 65 years of age.



Christian Activity Center

The CAC is a children's ministry located in Fairmont City focusing on year-round ministry that begins with the school year and continues with private tutoring all year long. The first Monday of June will begin the CAC summer lunch program. For more than 10 years, the CAC has fed 60 to 100 moms and children in the park of Fairmont City at 12 p.m. each weekday.

Christmas in July

This ministry brings the joy of the Christmas season to the residents of Elmwood Nursing Home. They have a delightful afternoon filled with a puppet show, cookies, and gifts. The residents also get to hear the Gospel and to top it all off, Santa pays them a surprise visit.

Community Outreach

Community Outreach provides clothing, shoes, toiletries, foodstuffs, and hot meals to the homeless and underprivileged in our communities. They are part of a team of churches/organizations that support three outreaches each month. (listed below)

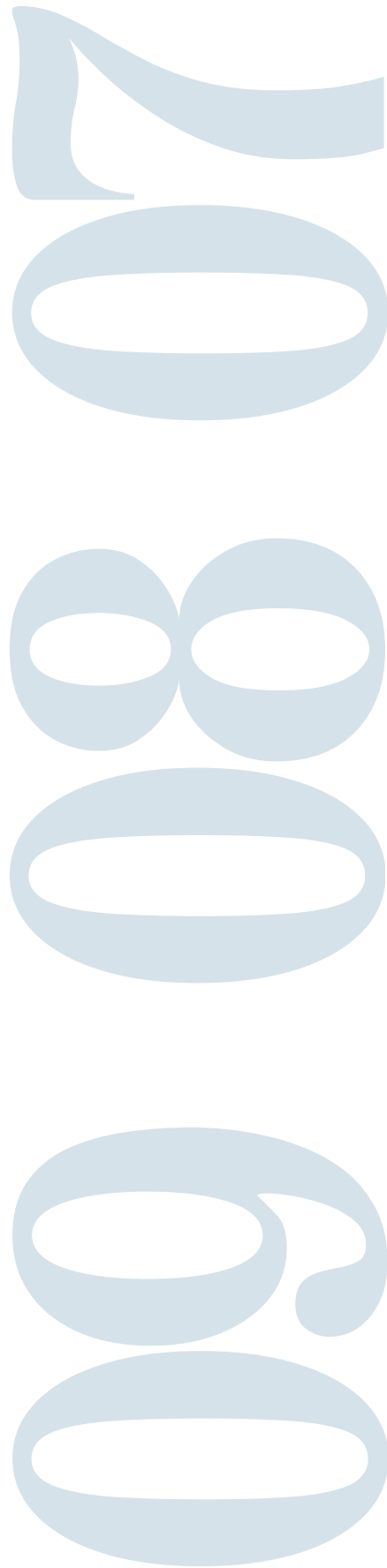
Good Samaritan Ministries
